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How many circumcised?

Hansi asks:

Hi,

I am very interested, how many in your class, or in your sport, are circumcised. Is there a difference with age?

In my class (year 9) 3 out of 11 boys are, while in tennis I know of two out of about 7 at my age.

In table-tennis 0 out of 11 and in my former school class 1 out of 21.
We always shower after sport, all naked together.

We are 13 boys in my class, of whom 5 are circumcised. I think that is pretty normal, since all of my best mates are also circumcised.

In my class 4 out of 13 boys are circumcised.
AS for my football club, we shower together after training and I've seen that many are circumcised. Out of 20 boys, 10 no longer have a foreskin. I am quite sure it is age-dependent. I have seen that the younger ones are more often circumcised. Matze

Classmates, out of 16 boys 9 are circumcised. Sports club (judo) out of about 15 boys some 5 are circumcised. Max, year 9.

Including me 11 out of 15 boys are circumcised, in my sports club only 2.. I don't think age has anything to do with it. My friends all still have foreskins. Florian, year 8

In my class 5 out of 11 boys are circumcised, in football club 8 out of 20.

In my class only a few are circumcised, 4 out of 15 boys. In the sport club 6 out of 18 no longer have a covering.

In year 9 we are 14 boys, of whom 5 are circumcised.

I am in year 10. We are 14 boys, and of them 6 are circumcised.

It is totally normal to have no foreskin. I am in year 7 and in my class very many boys are circumcised. In swimming classes I've seen that only very few still have a foreskin, and even with most of them you can see the glans. I think there is nothing to it, and many boys feel the same way.

Hey, I've got a question. Why were you or your friends circumcised, and does it make a difference? Many thanks. Lenax3

It makes no difference, it's just more hygienic when the glans isn't covered. My younger brother was therefore circumcised at age 13. In my class (year 10) many boys have no foreskin. This is pretty normal today. I was done at 14. Flo.

In my class there are 14 boys, and of them 6 are circumcised.

How do you manage with the dressing when you get circumcised? Do you have to take it off each time you pee?

I don't know exactly how many at our school, but in the changing rooms at school swimming you can see the glans of many boys. I think that just under half are circumcised.

In my class only I am cut and I'm cool with that. The rest of my class are girls. And in basketball, there are only about 2 or 3.

Hey guys, as a woman I reckon that 10 to 20% of boys are cut. But that is only an estimate from the sauna or naturist park. For me as a woman, it is a good thing when boys are circumcised.

Hi, I'm a trainee nurse. I've read that 10% of boys are circumcised in Germany, but I have no evidence whether that is true. I know girls have written to you before that cut is better, but the guys must make the decision themselves to have it done. Anja

Lara Caro and Anja, I must put you straight. I am now 18 and for me it was done routinely by a doctor when I was 14, because it is better for both boys and girls. I was sceptical, but now I find the look and feel really great.

I had a little problem down there. My frenulum tore and the urologist said "repair it or do a proper job?" I was puzzled by this but she explained a proper job was a relatively high and tight circ. She took a lot of trouble over it and did a great job. I am still grateful to her for her classy work. Her advice was excellent and she explained everything in great detail. It was a little awkward to talk to a woman about this but she put me at my ease. The result was, as promised, the golden mean. Soft all mobile, and erect still a little movement for play. My wife is also totally convinced by the result although she initially wanted just the repair.
